Main Information:

- Signing on will take place in the Kentagon from 07:15 each day – Although please note that the circuit will be live from 09:00 on Friday and Saturday and 10:00 on Sunday! 😊
- Friday 14th you will receive breakfast and an **evening meal** in the circuit restaurant, and payment of £20
- Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th you will receive breakfast in the circuit restaurant and a packed lunch, and a payment of £10 for each day
- **IO BRIEFING:** Briefing for all IOs at 08:00 on FRIDAY and SATURDAY mornings, where we sign-on

ACU/BMCRC Training Certificate and ACU Registration/Accreditation:

- Minimum criteria – completion of the 5 main training module assessments (i.e. Marshalling Fundamentals, Safety, Flags, Incident Handling (Part One and Part Two) – 100% pass rate required. The Online Marshal Training is not mandatory but **strongly** recommended.
- A list of all Marshals and completed ACU Registration forms, for all those who have successfully completed the ACU training, will be sent to the ACU at the **end of March (the deadline)**.
- **ACU IMPORTANT NOTE:** On completion of the relevant online assessments, you should receive an email from me within a couple of days, confirming your successful completion, together with your certificate, an ACU Registration form and instructions on how to register on the ACU online system.
- **ACU Marshal / Official licences are FREE!**
- Please note that it is NOT a mandatory requirement to belong to the ACU if you want to Marshal with us, but if you do want to join the ACU and get an ACU Marshals licence, you will need to select your organising club as **British Motorcycle Racing Club Marshals Association**. Selecting British Motorcycle Racing Club means you would be registering as a racer instead of a Marshal, so please take particular care with this

Circuit/Camping Entrance:

Access to the Marshals campsite can be gained via the Main Gate from lunch time on Thursday 14th March.

MARSHALS, OFFICIALS AND MEDICS BBQ – SATURDAY NIGHT:

There will be a BBQ on the Saturday night, in the Marshals campsite. The Club will provide the food (usually burgers, sausages, cheese and buns, etc), and you just need to provide your own drink and any extras.

This is the first BBQ of the 2025 season and whilst I appreciate it may be a bit nippy, it will be so wonderful to see you there so I hope you can make it.

As usual, I would appreciate your help with unloading/loading the van and the putting up/taking down of the marquee and bbq.

A MASSIVE thank you to Gordon for his continued help with the BBQ. I'm sure you all join me in being forever grateful for all he does... his efforts provide an opportunity for those, who are so inclined, to gather socially together at the end of a day and share stories whilst munching on a sausage or two.

Camping and Power:

Camping will be available for Marshals, Medics and Officials in the Car Park on the left along Colin Chapman Way. Access to this is via the access road to the left of the toilet block and Kentagon. **Please do NOT camp anywhere else, or you WILL be asked to move.** Grass is available for tents.

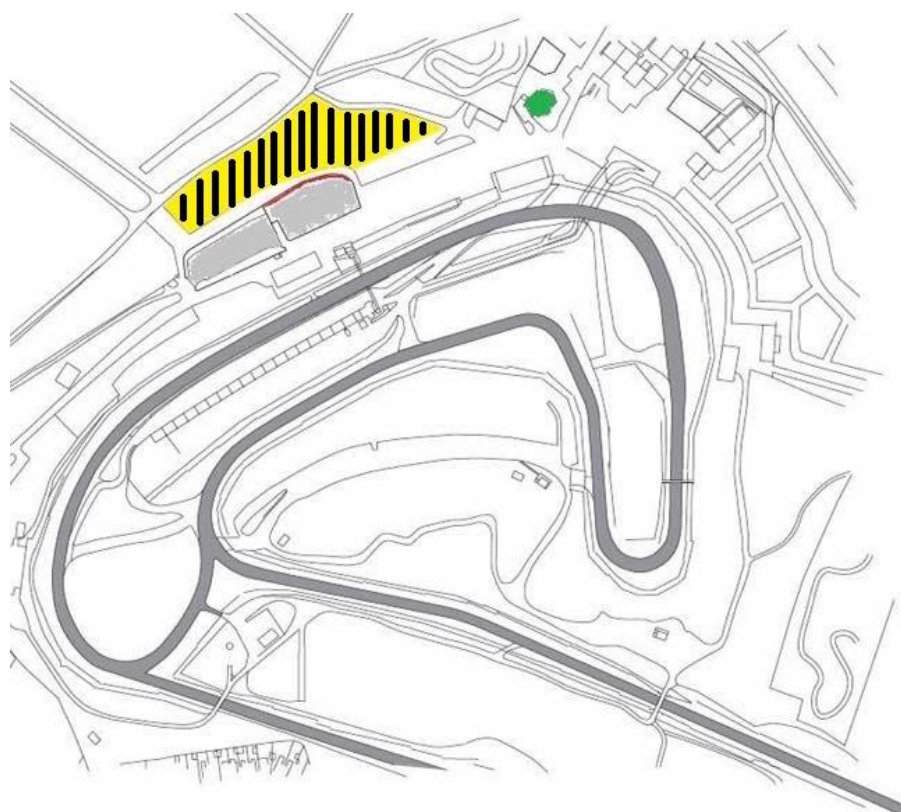
Entry to the campsite and outer paddock will be available from lunchtime on Thursday 14th March. There will be power available from the posts around the Expo site and you can run leads across the service road.





Please note that some of the usual power outlets alongside the Marshals camping area may not be in operation... this means there may be limited power. I will have the Marshals generator available and we will do what we can to help wherever possible

The Circuit Manager has asked us to emphasise that **ALL cables crossing the service road MUST have a cable protector covering them.** Anyone without a protector could find they are unplugged.

For those that are new to Marshalling or the power at Brands Hatch, you will need a 32A plug for the posts. Most of the regular Brands Marshals that camp over, have a 32A to Twin 16A adaptor, so if you find you're without the correct plug, please ask someone if they can help you out.

Marshals can camp on Sunday night but please leave the circuit on Monday morning.
